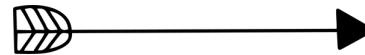

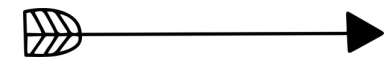

ENROLLMENT

The camp is open to all violin, viola, cello and string bass students. Those eligible for the middle school camp will have completed grades 5, 6, or 7, and have had at least one year of instruction on their instrument. Audition pieces should be comparable to music in the back of Suzuki Book One. Those eligible for the high school camp will have completed grades 8, 9, 10, or 11, and have had at least two years of instruction on their instrument. Beginning students can be any grade level and no previous experience is required.
